Scope

We are looking for articles which might cover some or all of the following material:

- outline traditional approaches to the subject
- open up new questions from a contemporary viewpoint
- outline current liberal, open and progressive approaches or viewpoints
- give some suggestions for further reading and links.

Audience

Our potential audience is:

- people attached to a church who feel isolated and unsupported in their doubts
- people who already have access to liberal/radical ideas but who want to know more
- people who feel themselves to be Christian at some level, but have given up on religion because they find traditional theology and liturgy unconvincing
- people from other outlooks and traditions within the wide spectrum of Christianity who wish to understand where we are coming from theologically, spiritually and liturgically.

We welcome articles in a range of styles to cover this diverse audience from the formal, using technical theological language, to the informal and conversational.

Length

No more than 1,500 - 2,000 words plus:

- suggestions for further reading/online links
- a short summary/abstract (optional)
- a list of keywords (optional).

Editing

All materials for the website will be reviewed by the Editorial Board which might request some amendments and which has the final authority over whether material is published on the website or not.

Copyright

Original work

We will ask for an undertaking that the material is your original work and that you have acknowledged all sources referred to, quoted or depended on.
